Raga Hamirkalyani:

A raga that is North Indian in flavour and handling, Hamir Kalyani thrives on its *pidis* — i.e catch phrases which establish its identity. Two *madhyamas (Suddha and Prati)*, and two *nishadas (kaisiki and kakali)* feature in this raga in addition to the other swaras. A very beautiful raga which offers immense scope for swaying *sangatis*, *jaru-s* and graceful vocal negotiations, Hamirkalyani has been introduced in the South due to the compositions of Thyagaraja and Dikshitar. Cinema music has put this raga into ample use and some of the greatest hits are based in this raga.
